ABOUT CAROLYN MCKAY.....

Newcastle-born, Carolyn McKay recently completed postgraduate studies at Sydney College of the Arts where she researched eyewitness testimony in murder trials and produced a body of work, *Word of Mouth*. Carolyn has been a finalist twice in the Archibald. Other major exhibitions include the Portia Geach Memorial Award, *Salon des Refusés, 10x10x10* (Mosman Art Gallery), Fishers Ghost Art Award, Conrad Jupiters Art Prize, Redlands Westpac Art Prize, The Waterhouse Natural History Prize, John Glover Art Prize, Waverley Art Prize and the Mosman Art Prize.

Overseas group exhibitions at Pargas City Gallery, Finland, The Emily Harvey Foundation, New York and MOMA, Wales, as well as Museu Brasileiro da Escultura, São Paulo, Brazil.

Solo shows at James Harvey Gallery, Cooks Hill Galleries and Dedspace, SCA.

Australian public collections include Blacktown City Council, Bundanon Trust, Mosman Art Gallery/Mosman Council and Waverley Council. The unbound *A Book About Death* collection (group show in New York) has been acquired by the LA County Museum of Art Research Library, Los Angeles and MOMA, New York. The *Um Livro Sobre a Morte* works have become part of the permanent collection of Museu Brasileiro da Escultura, São Paulo, Brazil, as will the latest *A Book About Death* exhibition at MOMA, Wales.
